Directions to Ludowici Tile Community Building

When traveling South on State Route 13, as you enter New Lexington, turn right at the "T" onto Ohio Route 37 (at Ridenour Auto Group). Travel 0.3 miles and turn Left where Route 37 makes a sharp right turn (Perry County Fair Grounds). Travel 0.1 mile and turn Right onto Tile Plant Road (at the "T"). Travel approximately 0.8 miles and turn Left into Ludowici Tile Plant at their second entrance. Inside the gate, parking is on the right and the Community Building stands alone in front of you.

When traveling West into New Lexington on St. Rt. 345, turn Left at the second stop light onto Broadway (which becomes St Rt 37) [CVS is at this corner]. Continue traveling on Broadway/St. Rt. 37 for approximately 1.0 miles (through 2 stop lights) and turn Left where Route 37 makes a sharp right turn (Perry County Fair Grounds). Travel 0.1 mile and turn Right onto Tile Plant Road (at the "T"). Travel approximately 0.8 miles and turn Left into Ludowici Tile Plant at their second entrance. Inside the gate, parking is on the right and the Community Building stands alone in front of you.

When traveling toward New Lexington on Tunnel Hill Road, continue until the road dead ends into a "T" at Brook Street. Turn Right on Brook Street and travel to the first traffic light at Broadway (CVS is at this light). Turn Left and travel on Broadway/St. Rt. 37 for approximately 1.0 miles (through 2 stop lights) and turn Left where Route 37 makes a sharp right turn (Perry County Fair Grounds). Travel 0.1 mile and turn Right onto Tile Plant Road (at the "T"). Travel approximately 0.8 miles and turn Left into Ludowici Tile Plant at their second entrance. Inside the gate, parking is on the right and the Community Building stands alone in front of you.

There is a handicap entrance at the back of the building.
